Aerial pole takes Bendy's ground pole act to a new level. The pole is suspended from the ceiling and, if a winch or counter weight rigger is available, the pole also has the option to go horizontal! This act is truly mesmerising and will leave your guests with something to talk about for days!

Hammock is a beautiful, artistic and intricate apparatus. This act is great if you are looking for a slow and arty ambience for your event with a sensual and sophisticated vibe.

Silks is another traditional circus discipline, which also looks incredible as a duet. You will see Bendy delicately hang from, roll through and bend between two pieces of beautiful fabric. This is ideal for venues with tall ceilings.

When aerial is not possible at your venue, a hand balancing performance is the perfect option! Bendy has been hand balancing since the age of 9. Watch her enchantingly dance on her hands to the beat of the music. This act can also be added on as a second performance during your event.

AERIAL RIG

If your venue doesn't have a load tested beam or rigging point, booking the rig is an amazing option. Bendy's rig can be used both inside and outside, so you can have an aerial performance anywhere!



HIRE COST £200

SPACE REQUIREMENTS

The rig is 5 metres tall. If used inside it requires a ceiling height of at least 5 metres. It also requires floor space of 5 metres squared.

DETAILS

- Requires at least 3 helpers at the venue, plus Bendy will usually bring one assistant.
- The rig weighs 75kg and is load tested to 1200kg

Please allow 20 minutes assembly and disassembly time.

 - Car access close to the performance area is required





Bendy has lots of versatile, beautiful and unique costumes available. Depending which act she is performing, certain costumes are more suitable than others. For pole, her legs and stomach will have to be available for grip. For aerial, her legs and stomach will need to be covered up to avoid burns.

For a specific price for your event, please contact us with full details so that we can provide you with a detailed quotation.

As a guide, single acts start from £500 and two acts start from £750. Additional costs may also be incurred for travel, flights, free standing aerial rig and if a professional rigger is required to either visit a venue to check suitability or help rig equipment. VAT is charged at 20% for all UK events, and a **£200 deposit** is required upon booking.

In addition to her main acts, slower, ambient sets can be requested whilst guests are arriving or eating for example. Bendy is available for max two sets, plus one ambient.

Bespoke choreography can be created for an additional fee of £250, to create a special performance unique to your event. Additional charges may apply if a new costume is required to suit the event theme.

ECHNICAL INFORMATION

 Rigging for aerial performances can be provided from i-beams, eye-bolts, trussing, structural beams, cranes, winches and other similar structures.

A solid ceiling in some capacity will be required for floor to ceiling pole performances. This could be a concrete ceiling, a joist or beam.

3. Rigging from trees is not recommended due to safety concerns.

4. Bendy is able to liaise with your venue directly to advise on the suitability of the structure for aerial performance.

5. Clear access to rigging points will be required for aerial performances, and the client will need to provide a ladder, scaffold tower, cherry picker (with certified operator) or similar equipment. Bendy can provide a rigger where necessary for more complex venues.

6. Each piece of aerial equipment requires the rigging point to be able to hold a breaking load of 500kg for solo acts or 1000kg for duo acts.

7. Assistance will be required to unload and reload equipment from the parking area to the performance area.

8. The client is liable to any injury or damage due to poor conditions.

9. The client is liable for any injury to the client or public as a result of lack of security measure in place.

11. Drinking water must always be available.

BOOKING TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Upon confirmation of booking, Bendy will require the client to complete a copy of her contract and make a deposit payment of £200. The remaining amount due is payable 7 days before the event.

2. Confirmation of themes, colours and type of act will be required at the time of booking.

3. Any bespoke choreography, costumes or equipment will also require confirmation at time of booking. An additional fee of £250 will be charged for bespoke choreography.

4. The client is responsible for providing any lighting required and for operation of all lighting.

5. The client is responsible for providing a suitable sound system for the venue and sound engineer. Bendy is happy to provide any music on CD, MP3 or similar and can provide all music in advance of the event.

6. Bendy will require a clean, secure, warm area (with clean and dry floor) with access to toilets to change, warm up and rest in. This area should be private and secure. She also requires a 20 minute call before her performance.
